<p>What numbers can you spot in the environment? Have a look out when you go out in the car/at the shops/at the park. Choose your favourite number and decorate it any way you wish.</p>	<p>Go for an autumn walk - talk to your grown up. Discuss. What did you see/hear/smell? How did you feel?</p> 	<p>Practise your sounds in your reading record - can you show a family member the actions that go with them?</p>
