Spring Term 2020

## Literacy

We are beginning the term by reading the book Viking Boy by Tony Bradman. We will look at character and setting descriptions and write our own stories based around this.

We are then going to study 'The Highwayman' narrative poem by Alfred Noyes.

## **Materials and their Properties**

**PE:** Circuits and Gymnastics

#### Music

The topics will be Voice and Rhythm, including following graphic notation and performing as a group whilst maintaining a rhythm and pulse.

**Computing:** We are Artists – we will be exploring the effect of loops and 'repeat' commands in creating effective programs which we will then apply to creating abstract patterns.

In **MFL** we will revisit what we have learned already to ensure that the children have a good grounding from which to further progress their knowledge. We will then extend their conversational skills.
