A big focus in Foundation Stage is on developing self-confidence and promoting communication skills. We would like to give your child the opportunity to prepare a little talk at home to share with their class. It does not need to be learnt as we just want the children to feel comfortable when speaking to others. It would be helpful if they could practice what they intend to say at home before presenting it to the class. It needs to be no more than 2 minutes long on a topic that interests your child. They can talk about a hobby, sport, their family, holiday, or an outing they have been on. They can bring in a prop to show the class but we discourage toys. Please can we remind you to only bring in items on your show and tell days and not at other times.

Show and tell will take place on a Friday in different colour groups.
