Personal, Social and Emotional

- Play feelings charades with your family (e.g. excited, frustrated)
- Have a dance party with your family
- Make an Easter basket and give it to someone



Communication and Language

- Share Easter or Spring stories - talk about the characters, settings and how characters are feeling
- Can you act out or re-create a story?

Physical

- On your daily walk count how many rainbows in windows you can see/how many birds you can see/what flowers you can see.
- Write a list when you get home

Literacy

- Keep a diary of what you do - can you write a sentence or draw a picture every day?
- Tricky word songs on you tube
- Practise all your sounds and actions

Maths

- How many patterns can you wear today? (socks, tops etc.)
- Make Easter nest cakes using your chosen cereal and melted chocolate.
- Easter egg hunt: How many eggs did you find? Can you draw a map and/or describe their position?



Understanding the World

- Fill a sink or bath with water - test out at least 5 items to see what sinks and what floats
- Go on a nature walk. What new life can you see?
- Grow your own flowers - make sure you look after them!



Expressive Arts and Design

- Make your own Easter Cards (you could post one to your friends or family)
- An example would be to make fingerprint bunnies and chicks.

- Look outside your window and find 5 things that God created. Why is each of these things important?
- Read the Easter Story together
- Reflect how we are living like Jesus this Lent - have we achieved our Lenten promises?
