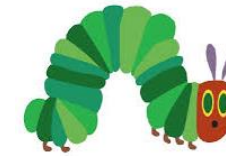


Reception Home Learning: Week 1

The Hungry Caterpillar



Understanding of the World

Go on a walk or explore your garden. Collect natural materials eg leaves, twigs, feathers, petals and create a natural picture.

Literacy

Create a 'Hungry Caterpillar' story map, showing the foods the caterpillar eats.

Maths

Make a fruit salad with your parents. Talk about halving and cutting the fruit up into 2 parts, 5 parts, 10 parts all the while counting while you do it. Then enjoy eating your fruit salad.

Physical

Make some homemade play dough. Then make a caterpillar or butterfly out of playdough.

Expressive Art and Design

Use junk modelling materials to make a caterpillar or butterfly.
