<p><u>Communication and Language</u> Listen to the story - who are the characters? What happened at the beginning, middle and end? Can you order the story sequencing cards? Can you think of another way Mr and Mrs Grinling could trick the seagulls? What would you do?</p>	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u> How do you think Hamish felt in the story when he was put in the basket going along the wire? Have you ever felt scared or worried? What did you do to feel better? What foods do you like and dislike? Would you eat Mr Grinling's lunch?</p>
<p><u>Physical Development</u> Create a lighthouse using construction materials (e.g. Lego). Have a go at the seaside cutting skills sheet.</p>	<p><u>Literacy</u> Can you write a speech bubble from Hamish's point of view? How do you think he felt going along the wire in the basket? Or you can write a speech bubble from the Seagull's point of view.</p>
<p><u>Mathematics</u> Can you order the fish numbers 0-20. Cut them out and stick them down in order. Have a go at the I spy sheets for numbers 11 to 20.
