Working mathematically

By the end of Nursery, children will recognise simple number patterns and be able to count reliably to 10. They will begin understand that numbers can be regrouped in different ways. They will use a range of Mathematical vocabulary to describe concepts and make comparisons.

Making comparisons

Children will make comparisons between objects in practical concepts. They will say which object is heavier, lighter, longer and shorter.

Classification

Children will describe how objects or groups of objects are similar and different to each other. They will use criteria such as shape, colour and pattern.

Pattern

The children will explore and describe simple patterns.

Subitising

Children will recognise simple number patterns without the need to count. They will play games using dice and dominoes. They will also create number patterns using a variety of equipment.

Counting

Children will learn to count using simple 1:1 correspondence and saying number names in order.
